

Baird Center Mall Slider Load Zone Instructions

ENTRANCE (during construction): corner of 6th Street & Wells Street

- All vehicles Loading in at the Mall Slider, must use the corner of 6th Street & Wells Street.
 - Security attendant at the street will have a list of vendors to check if allowed to enter the area.
- Due to construction, we ask that no more than 10 vehicles are allowed into the area to Load In / Load Out at a time.

NO PARKING: vehicles are not allowed to park in this area.

- Load In:
 - Vendors will be instructed to unload their items and immediately return to move vehicle to allow other vendors to load in.
 - Vehicles should park on the South side (non-construction) side of the street
- Load Out:
 - Vendors should have all items packed up and ready to go before bringing vehicle to the Load Out area.
 - Vehicles should park on the South side (non-construction) side of the street


EXIT (during construction): corner of 6th Street & Wells Street
